Hello Mia,

This letter should clarify our resolve to never hold the NKR VGL numbers, that could be controlled by us and UC Davis, hostage from you.

The NKR believes in letting you determine the extent you need to utilize registry services. We do not mandate that animals be DNA tested because we think that you and your buyers know best what serves your needs in terms of surety of pedigree as balanced with economy. If you and your customer want the animals DNA tested in order to add value, we can provide that service as inexpensively as anyone in the business. If you and your customers don't feel that it is required on less expensive animals, that's fine also. When you have us provide you with DNA testing of your animals, you can rest assured that you can use those numbers any way you want to. You will also transfer the use of those VGL numbers to those who purchase your NKR registered goats.

The registration number issued to each goat and the VGL number issued to each goat add value to the goat, belong with the goat, and should travel with it in usefulness.
